

**PROVIDER ADVISORY #2026-006**  
**REVISED RULES FOR LICENSURE OF RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES AND ADULT DAY TRAINING PROGRAMS**

**ACTION REQUIRED**

**EFFECTIVE DATE: 3/26/2026**

Please be advised that Rule 65G-2, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), is updated effective March 26, 2026. This rule has been revised based on public comment received from providers and other stakeholders during the rule promulgation process. This rule governs the licensing of and standards for residential facilities and adult day training (ADT) programs that serve individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, as defined in section 393.063, Florida Statutes (F.S.). Revisions to the rule were made to add clarity, facilitate more precise implementation of statutory requirements, remove unnecessary regulations, and strengthen standards to better ensure the health, safety, and welfare of individuals with developmental and intellectual facilities who reside or participate in facilities and programs licensed by the Agency.
