

WSC ADVISORY #2026-002
PLAN VALIDATION RULES IN ICONNECT TEMPORARY CHANGE

ACTION REQUIRED

EFFECTIVE DATE: FEBRUARY 10, 2026

To further assist Waiver Support Coordinators (WSCs) in updating authorizations for clients who qualify for the new monthly service codes for Adult Day Training (ADT) and Prevocational services (Life Skills Development 3 and 4), as outlined in [WSC Advisory #2025-012 LSD 3 and LSD 4 New Monthly Service Codes – Authorizations](#), the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) worked with the iConnect vendor to temporarily deactivate the Plan Validation Rule 18, “Consumers can only receive transportation services if also receiving Life Skills 2, 3 & 4 services.”

To comply with requirements in the [Developmental Disabilities Individuals Budgeting Waiver Services Handbook](#), incorporated by reference into Rule 59G-13.070, Florida Administrative Code, to receive iBudget Waiver funded transportation services, clients must have Supported Employment, Adult Day Training, or Prevocational services on their cost plan.

APD is temporarily deactivating the plan validation rule to reduce the workload of WSCs and decrease the time needed to update the impacted authorizations. APD expects to reactivate this rule prior to June 1st, 2026, to facilitate the new fiscal year cost plan activities and provider authorizations. Please use this time to update authorizations for providers that need to bill for services.
