UPDATES TO THE RESIDENTIAL REFERRAL FORM IN ICONNECT
ICONNECT USER ACTION REQUIRED

EFFECTIVE DATE: MARCH 27, 2026

The Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) is excited to announce updates to the **Residential Referral Form** in iConnect.

The updates allow APD Staff, Waiver Support Coordinators (WSCs), WSC Mentees and Consumer-Directed Care Plus (CDC+) Consultants to accurately identify the client's **Current Approved Residential Habilitation Level**, as applicable, and **Approved Residential Habilitation Level** with the addition of the following options on the form:

- **Standard Minimal**
- **Standard Moderate**
- **Standard EX1** (Standard Extensive 1)
- **Standard EX2** (Standard Extensive 2)
- **BF Minimal** (Behavior Focus Minimal)
- **BF Moderate** (Behavior Focus Moderate)
- **BF EX1** (Behavior Focus Extensive 1)
- **BF EX2** (Behavior Focus Extensive 2)
